

HORIZON TIRE

Limited Standard Warranty Policy & Procedures

Horizon Tire Corporation warrants subject to the terms, conditions and limitations stated herein...tires, tubes and wheels to be free from defects in materials and workmanship.

WHAT IS COVERED AND FOR HOW LONG

Horizon Tire warrants that if a tire becomes unserviceable due to an eligible adjustable condition during the tread life (defined below) within 4 years from the original date of manufacture the tire will be replaced by an equivalent new tire supplied by Horizon Tire. A replacement charge (defined below) may be required in order to obtain a replacement tire or credit can be granted based on tread remaining.

OTHER THAN FIRST QUALITY TIRES

Horizon Tire radial and bias tires have the same warranty as first quality tires except for the appearance or other conditions that caused the tires to be classified as other than first quality.

TUBES

Tubes removed from service due to an eligible adjustable condition will be replaced without charge

TREAD LIFE

When the tread becomes worn down to 2/32^{nds} of an inch (shown by tread wear indicators molded into the tread grooves) the tire is worn out and this warranty ends.

REPLACEMENT CHARGE

The Replacement Charge will be determined by multiplying the consumer's pre-determined purchase price by the percentage of original tread depth worn from the tire. The consumer must pay for mounting, balancing and any other additional charges, such as taxes or the acceptance by the consumer of same priced and quality replacement tire.

WHAT IS NOT COVERED

This warranty does not cover tires that become unserviceable due to:

1. Conditions resulting from road hazards such as (A) impact damage, (B) cuts, (C) snags or (D) punctures.
2. Conditions resulting from (A) improper installation, (B) wheel misalignment or (C) tire/wheel assembly imbalance.
3. Conditions resulting from consumer damage such as (A) improper tire and vehicle maintenance, (B) misuse, (C) abuse, (D) accident.
4. Ride complaints after the first 25% tread wear.
5. Irregular wear conditions
6. Ozone or weather checking on tires over 4 years from date of manufacture.
7. Over 30 days from purchasing or tread wear more than 1/32nd to full tread for out of round.

Only tires sold and /or adjusted within the 48 contiguous continents United States, District of Columbia and Canada are covered by this Warranty.

REPLACEMENT WARRANTY

If consumer receives a replacement tire under the term of this warranty the replacement tire will be covered by the warranty Horizon Tire then gives for that tire.

CONDITIONS AND EXCLUSIONS

Any tire or tube, no matter how well constructed, may fail in service or otherwise become unserviceable due to conditions beyond the control of the manufacturer. Nothing in this Warranty is intended to be a representation by Horizon Tire that tire or tube failure cannot occur.

HORIZON TIRE DISCLAIMS ANY LIABILITY FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

The cost of mounting, demounting, balancing, road service charge, FET charge, disposal fees, or applicable taxes are payable by the customer. (Some states do not allow exclusion of incidental or consequential damages so this limitation or exclusion may not apply to you.)

CONSUMER RIGHTS

This warranty gives you specific legal rights and may also have other rights which vary from state to state.

OBLIGATIONS

When making a claim you must cut a serial number(s) off the tire along with tire's picture(s) and return it OR you can return the tire or tube to be replaced to Horizon Tire. Horizon Tire's Adjustment Form has to be filed and signed with customer's signature. Claims must be made within 30 days of discovery of irregularity. Horizon Tire reserves the right to inspect all products before making adjustments.

Proper vehicle and tire care is necessary to obtain the expected wear from a tire. It is your obligation to properly maintain your tires and the vehicle upon which they are mounted, including: (A) operating your tires at the inflation pressure recommended by the vehicle manufacturer, (B) keeping your tire/wheel assemblies in balance and (C) proper wheel alignment.
